### **UPDATE:**

Effingham Police Department wishes to thank everyone for spreading the word in the earlier attempt to locate the endangered persons.

Both persons have been located and are safe in Union County, Illinois. The family has been contacted to arrange for their return back to Effingham.

### ***Endangered Persons Advisory – Attempt to Locate***

*An Endangered Persons Advisory has been issued by Effingham Police for two missing individuals: an 84 year old white female, Margaret Quick, and an 89 year old white male, Charles E. Stone, who left the Villas of Hollybrook to attend an event in Effingham last night, June 1<sup>st</sup>, but never arrived. Quick and Stone were last seen at approximately 9:00 P.M. on SB 155 at Exit 52.*

*Quick is described as a white female, 84 years old, 5'4" tall, with blue eyes and gray hair. Stone is a white male, 89 years old, 6'0" tall, with brown eyes and gray hair, driving a Silver Lincoln Continental with a cloth top, with Missouri handicapped license plate CA89A.*
