**West Jefferson Avenue Water Main Replacement - Phase 2**

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Sealed proposals for the *City of Effingham, West Jefferson Avenue Water Main Replacement - Phase 2*, will be received by the City of Effingham, Illinois, 201 E. Jefferson, Effingham, IL 62401 in the office of the City Clerk until 10:00 a.m. October 8, 2019 and will then be publicly opened and read.

The work generally consists of furnishing and installation of water system piping, fittings, valves, and appurtenances for potable water. Installation will consist of 10" PVC RJ Yelomine HDD and 10" PVC SDR-21 Water Main along design route. Contractor is responsible for installation of the proposed main as shown on the plans, installing valves, hydrants, casing, fittings, connections, services and disconnections. This work also includes surface restoration with various pavements and curbing as detailed in the plans and specifications titled "City of Effingham West Jefferson Avenue Water Main Replacement -Phase 2." The proposed water main is being installed to replace an existing older water main.

The Contract Documents, consisting of Advertisement for Bids, Instructions for Bidders, Proposal, Bid Bond, General Conditions, Special Provisions, Payment Bond, Performance Bond, Notice of Award, Notice to Proceed, Change Order, Specifications, and Addenda may be examined at the following locations:

Plans, specifications and documents are on file in the office of the City Engineer of the City of Effingham and at the office of the Consulting Engineers, Farnsworth Group, Inc., 400 W. Jefferson Avenue, Suite A, Effingham, IL 62401. Copies of the plans and specifications may be obtained at the offices of the Consulting Engineers, Farnsworth Group, Inc., 400 W. Jefferson Avenue, Suite A, Effingham, IL 62401 upon payment of \$50.00 (nonrefundable) for each set.


Each proposal shall contain the name of every person or firm interested in the same and shall be accompanied by bid bond, certified check, bank draft, or cashier's check payable to the order of the Treasurer, City of Effingham, in an amount not less than 5% of the proposal.

The City of Effingham reserves the right to reject any or all bids, waive or not waive any informality in the bids, and to accept any bid which it deems most favorable to the City. It is agreed that this bid may not be withdrawn for a period of 45 days from opening thereof or it will be subject to forfeit the 5% Bid Bond provided with the bid.

It is anticipated that a Notice of Award of a contract will be issued within 30-to-60 days of the date bids are received and that a Notice to Proceed will be issued within 10 days of the date of the Notice of Award if contractor provides proper insurance and bonding in a timely manner.

Work on this project is subject to the Prevailing Wage Act (820 ILCS 130). Prevailing Wages, as determined by the Illinois Department of Labor and the current Prevailing wage ordinance approved by the City Council, shall be paid. The submission of monthly certified payrolls to the City of Effingham will be required. Work on this project is subject to the Illinois Substance Abuse Prevention on Public Works Project Act (820 ILCS 265) as enacted by P.A. 95-0635.
